In case of an emergency after hours, please report to security, who will record the details and take the necessary steps.

Payment

When arriving in office hours, please check in and settle your account at the office.
When arriving after office hours, please check in and settle account the next day before 10H00.

Resort Facilities

We do sell wood, briquettes, fire lighters, ice and ice cream at the office.

We have 2 laundromats onsite.

Two washing machines and two tumble dryers at the Beach Park next to the ladies' ablution block.

One washing machine and one tumble dryer behind the men's ablution block at Top Park.

Tokens for the machines are sold at the office.

We have a Tidal Pool in front of the beach park.

Swimming beach +/- 200 meter to the right from the beach park.

To the left there is also Granny's tidal pool.

TV room.

Jungle Gym on the grass area at the Hotel.

Campers are welcome to use the facilities at the hotel.

The hotel swimming pool is for hotel residents only.

You are welcome to make use of the facilities at the Country Club.

Holiday enjoyment rules

In any well-run establishment some common-sense rules need to be enforced to ensure your hard-earned holiday is a pleasure.

Please accept our rules in the spirit in which they have been drawn up.

- The campsite only includes one vehicle – vehicle permits are not transferable from one vehicle to another extra vehicle will required to pay R70 per vehicle per night.
- Only resident's day visitors permitted and day fee payable at the office – to sign in at the security gate – cost is R30 pp and R40 per car.
- Only resident's overnight visitors permitted – to sign in at the security gate and report to the office - fee payable at the office.
- No pets allowed.
- R500.00 deposit is required for afterhours walk-in bookings.
- Departure time is strictly 10.00am, in consideration of new guest arriving after a long and tiring journey.
- Arrival time from 11.00 for camping and 14.00 for the Park Homes.
- If the park is not advised of a non-arrival or date change to your booking – the site will be offered for re-occupation at 10h00 on the 2nd day after booked date of arrival.
- Management takes no responsibility for any loss or damage whilst on the property.
- Need blue plug for electricity – we do have at the office for R160.
- Bring own braai, +/- 1 meter off the ground – only a few to hire at the office.
- No plastic pegs allowed on artificial grass.
- Campers can use the swimming pool at the country club.
- No loud music or bad behaviour /excessive drinking / parties will be tolerate.
- Park must be quiet after 22h00. Should there be any complaints you agree to be given one warning before being evicted with no refund.
- The use of fireworks / weapons is prohibited.
- Only one caravan / tent trailer / motorhome or two small tents and a maximum of six persons that include children are permitted per site.
- Parking on adjacent sites is inconsiderate and forbidden – extra parking on top at the office.
- Children under 3 stay free, 3 to 11 pay 30% of adult rate, 12 to 15 pays 60% of adult rate, 16 years and older pay full rate.
- No washing lines between trees, washing lines are at the top park at the ablutions.
- Due to recycling, the rubbish bins are located at the ablutions.
- No plastic sheets – only perforated mats.
- All items (RIG) must fit onto your site with your vehicle.
- Small children should be supervised when using the ablution facilities.
- Please keep ablutions and sculleries neat and tidy at all times.
- No cleaning of fish in the park – must be done at the sea.
- Driving in and out of the park after midnight is only allowed in the event of an emergency.
- Speed limit 15km/h.
